Governor Training and Development Programme 23-24

Dear Governor,

Thank you for your interest in Camden Learning's Training and Development programme. The programme offers a range of opportunities to develop as a governor, with a number of new speakers and courses, together with courses covering areas of perennial importance.

We particularly hope you will join us at the new format Camden Governor Briefing and at the Conference in the spring.

Major changes and highlights to this year's programme are below. Looking forward to seeing you at event through the year. Training at a glance is available below

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Camden Governor Briefing (termly)

Once a term, we will offer a rapid fire briefing highlighting key updates for all governors via Zoom; these will be available to all governors free of charge and all governors will be sent an invite.

This will be recorded to allow playback at other times as a video or podcast (and available via Governor Hub for future reference). This will be led and chaired by Camden Learning.

Chairs' Network (termly)

We are offering a termly in person meeting focused on Chairs, with significant opportunities for discussion and networking. Chairs will split into separate phase groups (Primary and Secondary) for part of the meeting.

Global Majority Governors' Network

22-23 saw the launch of the Global Majority Governors Network, jointly with Islington Council. This group, aimed at Black, Asian and Other Ethnicity governors but open to all, met three times, twice in Camden and once in Islington, with a high number of governors at each event.

At each meeting, along with ample opportunity for networking, two key themes are discussed, chosen by the Chairs of the meeting. Themes discussed during the year included the performance of groups, the role of the Arts, the role of schools in supporting pupils with SEND and recruitment onto boards.

Equalities and Diversity

Our equality training sessions this year will be led by Carla Myrie, a former Deputy Headteacher and currently EDI consultant to Wandsworth and Richmond LEAs. This



is an area of great importance and interest for our governors. Other sessions in this area include

- Orlene Badu on becoming an Anti-Racist School
- Daniel Brook from Neuro Diversity Specialists on neuro-diverse boards
- Shekeila Scarlett on her path from pupil at risk of exclusion to Chair of Governors

SEND and Safeguarding

We have introduced network meetings aimed at SEND and Safeguarding governors. This is to allow a more detailed focus on the particularities of those roles, and a reduction in the introductory material contained in our training sessions.

Attendance and Behaviour

We have new sessions on Attendance and Secondary Behaviour, honing in on key priorities within Camden.

Clerks' Briefing

At the clerks' request, all sessions will now be hybrid, allowing clerks to meet or to attend virtually if they prefer. We will also be offering the same format for our Secondary and Primary Data Sessions. This reflects our commitment to continue to update and innovate within our programme.

Schools Finance

We will offer Management of School Finances and Financial Efficiencies to offer different perspectives on this important and perennial topic.

Inclusive Governing Bodies with Shekeila Scarlett



This session will allow Governors to hear from Shekeila Scarlett, chair of governors on Stoke Newington Secondary School Board. Shekeila is one of the UK's youngest Chairs at 26, and was featured in a <u>story</u> by the BBC

At the age of 12, Shekeila faced permanent exclusion, which was overturned on appeal. The process of encountering a governing body at such a young age was a key motivating factor in her wanting to bring younger voices to tables and spaces they usually wouldn't be in.

Through and beyond her current roles, Shekeila is mentoring and coaching young adults to get into governance and leadership as well as currently working on developing her own mentoring programme to address inequalities and provide opportunities. Beyond this, Shekeila continues to champion young adults to sit at the tables and enable change.

Neuro Diversity and Governing Boards



Approximately 1 in 7 individuals will have a neurodivergent processing difference such as dyslexia, dyspraxia, dyscalculia, dysgraphia, ADD, ADHD and ASC (Autistic Spectrum Condition).

This session, led by Daniel Brook from Neurodiversity Specialists, will introduce governors to working with neurodiversity, outlinging how to form and maintain an inclusive team. It will also assist governors in their role as employers, setting out how schools can be inclusive of neurodiverse staff.

Daniel founded Neurodiversity Specialists to provide organisations with the knowledge and tools to benefit from having a neurodiverse workforce and to understand the value of neurodiversity. Daniel is a British Dyslexia Association (BDA) qualified workplace needs assessor, with a background in career coaching and employability skills training, and has experience of supporting hundreds of neurodivergent individuals across many different sectors.
