The children were delighted to be able to take home their own copy of each book.

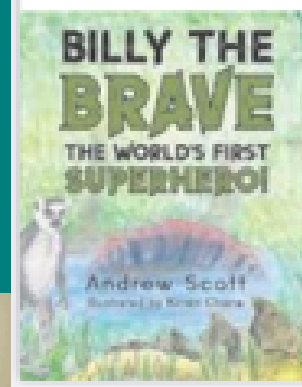
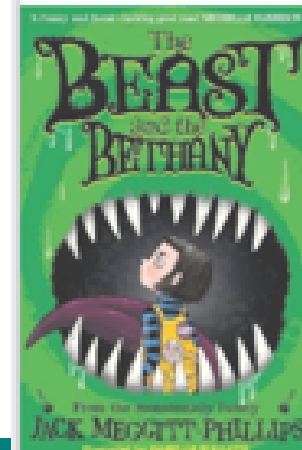
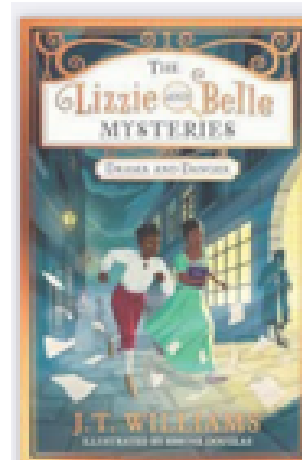




## Year 2 Reads Event
