

SEP Support Visits

A three-stage structured visit programme supporting SEPs in schools and community settings.

Stage 1 – Initial Mapping Visit

- Relationship-building with SEP leaders and host schools
- Understanding curriculum, staffing and learner engagement
- Alignment with safeguarding, governance and Camden priorities

Stage 2 – Governance and Policy Review

- Review of the Good Governance Management File
- Written feedback and recommendations
- Follow-up support and optional second visit

Stage 3 – Safeguarding Oversight Visit

- Safeguarding audit using Camden tools (e.g. Panel 11)
- Evidence of professional oversight for schools, parents and inspectors

Benefits

- Professional recognition
- Stronger safeguarding and governance
- Increased confidence from families, schools and inspectors

What experience is needed?

You should be an experienced subject leader with a track record of delivering good outcomes and an informed awareness of the latest developments in curriculum, teaching and learning and assessment in the subject. You should have experience of leading meetings to facilitate high quality discussion and be able to identify clear actions. Experience of being part of the existing network and leading CPD is desirable.
